Brittany Ksiezopolski



Brittany Ksiezopolski had an outstanding career as a member of the softball team at Hillsborough High School. Brittany was named 1st Team All-Conference, All Somerset County, and All-Area in 2009, 2010 and 2011. She was also named Somerset County Player of the year in 2009, 2010, and 2011. In 2010, Brittany was named 2nd Team All-State, All Groups and 1st Team All-State Group 4.

Brittany was a member of the Somerset County Championship Teams in 2010, where she pitched a shutout vs Montgomery 1-0, and again in 2011, where she was the winning pitcher vs Bridgewater 6-5 in 9 innings.

For her career, Brittany threw 444 and 2/3 innings pitched with 435 strikeouts, only 36 walks and 29 shutouts with an ERA (earned run average) of 0.98.

From 2008 to 2011, she had an overall career pitching record of 56-11.

In addition to her success at Hillsborough High School, Brittany went on to pitch in college playing for Stockton University. In 2013, she finished sixth in the nation in ERA. In 2015, she pitched a perfect game! For her overall college career, Brittany recorded 326 strikeouts, and an ERA of 1.62 and 16 shutouts.

Frank Mitchell

Frank Mitchell had an incredible 4-year career at Hillsborough High School as a member of the boys' basketball team.

In 2009, Frank was named 1st Team All-Conference, 1st Team All Somerset County, 2nd Team All-Area and Team MVP. As a senior in 2010, Frank was named 1st Team All-Conference, All Somerset County, All-Area, and Team MVP. He helped lead the Raiders to a 20-6 season record and their first-ever Group 4 State Championship Final

As a 4-year varsity letter winner, Frank scored 1,116 points. He is only 1 of 7 1,000-point scorers in the boy's program's history.

After graduating from Hillsborough High School, Frank was a recruited walk-on for the Rutgers men's basketball team, where he played 1 season. He then transferred to Ithaca College in his sophomore year. At Ithaca, Frank was a 3-year letter winner, where he amassed 1,298 points and 591 rebounds. He was a part of the teams that won the Empire 8 Conference in his sophomore and junior years. Frank was named Empire 8 All-Conference all 3 years and was the Empire 8 Conference MVP in his junior year. In addition, he was named All-Division 3, 2nd Team, East Region in his senior year.

Brittany Marcsisin



Brittany had a highly decorated gymnastics career at Hillsborough High School and will be remembered as one of the best Raider gymnasts in school history. As a freshman, she was named 1st Team All-Conference, was the Somerset County All-Around Champion, and was named to South Jersey Gymnastics League All-Star. As a member of the team, she helped lead the Raiders to a Conference Championship, County Championship and a Central Jersey Group II State Sectional Championship. In 2008, the team won the Somerset County Championship, and also posted an HHS school record and state record at that time with an overall score of 114.7 in a meet against South Brunswick.

In her junior year as an individual, Brittany was

the Conference Vault Champion, the Somerset County All-Around Champion in Vault, Balance Beam, and Uneven Bars, as well as the Central Jersey Group II State Sectional Vault Champion and New Jersey State Vault Champion (All Groups/All Sections). She was named 1st Team All-Conference, 1st Team All-State and The New Jersey Coaches All-State Team Member. As part of the team, she helped lead Hillsborough to the Somerset County Championship, the Central Jersey Group II State Sectional Championship, and placed 3rd at the New Jersey State Championships.

In 2010, Brittany went out with a bang having her best season ever! As an individual, she was the Conference Uneven Bars Champion, the Somerset County All-Around and Vault Champion, the Central Jersey Group II State Sectional All-Around, Vault, Uneven Bars, and Floor Champion as well as the NJ State Vault Champion (All Group/All Section). She was named 1st Team All-Conference for the 4th year in a row, 1st Team All-State for the second time, New Jersey Coaches Association All-State Team Member for the second time, and the Central Jersey Group II Gymnast of the Year! Brittany represented the State of New Jersey at the High School Nationals.

As a member of the team, they were undefeated during the regular season with a record of 9-0 and won the Conference Championship, the County Championship, the New Jersey Group II State Sectional Championship and finished 2nd in the New Jersey State Championships (All Groups/All Sections). Last but certainly not least, Brittany was named Hillsborough High School's Female Athlete of the Year!
