

Sandi Everett

An exceptional athletic career began for Sandi Everett at Hillsborough High School, where she excelled in both basketball and track. Beginning her varsity basketball career during her sophomore year, Sandi had three outstanding years, building a reputation for herself by being named to four first team honors. At the end of her HHS basketball career, Sandi was Central Jersey's Scoring Leader.

Throughout her entire track career, Sandi was named the team's MVP. Her amazing feats included amassing a total of 31 first place performances in the high jump, 100m hurdles, 400m hurdles, discuss, shuttle hurdles (with Adrienne Calamusa, Jill Sarapata, and Linda Peterson), and 3* hurdles (with Adrienne Calamusa and Jill Sarapata). Sandi had an unbelievable three consecutive state high jump titles. Sandi continued her athletic achievements by accepting a scholarship to the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, where she participated in the Heptathlon. Her stellar performances and her personal dedication resulted in her being named Captain of the UNC Women's Track Team for her senior year and selected to the NCAA Division I All-American Track team in the Heptathlon.

Most of us recall Sandi as being the penultimate competitor. It was not unusual to see her converting jump shots over defenders who were double teaming her. She was a perfectionist in track as well, sometimes reporting to the papers that although she won, she wasn't particularly pleased with a performance. It is that personal pride and outstanding track performance in the high jump that earned Sandi Everett a place in the Hillsborough High School Hall of Fame.
