Tom earned 11 varsity letters while at HHS. He lettered four times in football. He was a two-time All-area defensive linebacker in 1995-96, and three-time All-Somerset County selection. He went on to Farleigh Dickenson and had an outstanding career. To this day, Tom holds many of the defensive records. He was also a two-time All-American in 1998 and 2000. Tom was inducted into the FDU's Hall of Fame in 2006.

In wrestling, Tom earned four varsity letters. He was two-time district champion in 1995 and 1996. In the

Somerset County tournaments, he placed second three times and was a county champion in 1996. Tom was two-time state qualifier where he placed third and second.

As mentioned previously, Tom excelled in other sports. He earned two varsity letters in baseball and one in track. In only one year of track, Tom qualified for the Meet of Champions and came in second in the state sectionals for the javelin.
