
## **Michael Margelis**

Michael Margelis graduated from Hillsborough High School in 1998.

Michael participated in football, wrestling and lacrosse at HHS and excelled at all three.

In football, Michael was a 3-time letter winner and member of the 1996 football team that was undefeated in the regular season with a record of 10-0. In that same year he helped his team earn a 2<sup>nd</sup> place finish in the state. In his senior year, he was selected to the Skyland Conference All Star



Football team and played in the Sunshine Bowl. He was also recognized with the "Ironman' award for never missing a single practice.

In lacrosse, Michael 3-time varsity letter winner and a team leader in 4 of 5 recorded categories.

In wrestling, Steve's success stretches over many years. In 8<sup>th</sup> grade, he placed 4<sup>th</sup> in the state. At HHS, he was a 4-time varsity letter winner and in his freshman year he won the Most Improved Award. He was also a 3-time raider Invitational Champion, 2-time County Champion, and 2-time District Champion. Michael was also only the second HHS wrestler to be Region Champion. He was a 2-time state qualifier and graduated 3<sup>rd</sup> on the All-Time Win List with a record of 73-24. In his senior year he was selected as the Courier News First Team All –Area and First Team All-Somerset County. In that same year he won the HHS Achievement Award for wrestling, was selected as the HHS most outstanding Male Athlete and HHS Most Outstanding Senior Athlete,

After graduation from HHS, Michael continued his wrestling career at the Delaware Valley College where he was a 4-year letter winner, a 2-time MAC Conference runner up, a 2-time MAC conference champion, a 3-time national qualifier. He was officially ranked 8<sup>th</sup> in the nation in both 1999 and 2000 and graduate 4<sup>th</sup> on the all-time win list with 105 victories.

Michael currently resides here in Hillsborough.
