
Otto Gsell



Otto Gsell coached at Hillsborough High School from 1972 until his passing in the spring of 2000. He coached football during his entire career while also serving as the head wrestling and golf coach for the Raiders.

Prior to joining Hillsborough, Otto attended college at Morehead State where he played football and graduated in 1966. During his college career, he won a conference championship and was recognized by the governor of Kentucky. He went on to earn his Master's degree in Education and Recreation in 1971. Otto was also a decorated Army Sgt. and Vietnam veteran.

After arriving at Hillsborough in the fall of 1972, Otto became the assistant football coach until 1987 serving as the

defensive coordinator on two state championship teams, 1973 and 1980. He became the head football coach in 1988 and served in that position until 1993. Otto then became an assistant head coach from 1994-1998 serving as the head freshman coach.

From 1991-1999 Otto was the head golf coach and in 1993 his team became Region 5 state Champion. Otto also served as the head wrestling coach for several years.
