
Andrew Borsuk



Andrew Borsuk is a 2007 graduate of Hillsborough High School.

As a Raider Andrew earned many honors and quickly earned Golf Team Player of the Year honors as a freshman. In that same year, Andrew was named Hillsborough Beacon "Player of the Week."

During his sophomore year Andrew was named to the Skyland Conference, Delaware Division All Conference 1st team, All Area team 3rd team, and All State Group 4 1st team. He placed 7th in the Somerset County Tournament scoring a 77, and placed 4th in the Cherry Valley Tournament scoring a 74. That year the team finished 2nd place in the NJSSIA Central Jersey South Group IV, 8th place in the Cherry Valley Tournament, 2nd place in the Skyland Conference Tournament, and finished with a school record 13 wins and 5 losses.

Junior year was filled with more successes as Andrew was named earned honors including 1st team All-Conference, 1st Team All Area, 1st Team All State - Group IV, Player of the year, and Hillsborough Beacon Player of the

Week. That year Andrew had a 9 hole scoring average of 37.3, shot a 29 for 9 holes in a match at Royce Brook Country Club, setting a school record and tying the state record. During tournament play, Andrew finished the New Jersey North Group 4 sectionals in 1st place scoring a 79, the Cherry Valley Tournament in 7th place scoring a 75, the Somerset County Tournament in 3rd place scoring a 75, and the Conference Tournament in 10th place scoring an 81. That year he lead the team to 1st in the Somerset County Tournament, 3rd in the Skyland Conference tournament, 5th in the Cherry Valley Tournament, 1st in the New Jersey North Group 4 State Sectionals, and an overall record of 15 wins and 2 losses.

As Team Captain in his final year as Raider, Andrew again earned many honors including 1st Team All-Conference, 1st Team All Area, 3rd Team All State, and 1st Team All State Group IV. In tournament play he finished 3rd scoring a 75 in the Somerset County Tournament, he finished 5th in the Garden State Cup scoring a 75, he finished 2nd place in the Cherry Valley Tournament scoring a 72, and 4th in the Group IV Sectionals scoring a 78. The team finished 1st in Somerset County Tournament, 2nd in the Garden State Cup, 2nd in the Cherry Valley Tournament, and had an overall record of 17 wins and 2 losses. The team was in the top 10 team in the state, and shot a 9 hole school record of 177.

Andrew was very active in the local golf community and earned many honors outside of in-season play. He worked summer camps for kids including The First Tee in 2006/2007, and The Paradise Golf Range in 2005. He won the Otto Gesell Scholarship Award in 2007, the "Club Championship" at the Neshanic Valley golf course the 1st year the course opened. Andrew was the youngest to win it scoring a 79-76, and he also won the Rutgers University Junior Golf Tournament in 2006, with scores of 71-69-74-76. After finishing his career as a Raider, Andrew received a Division 1 Golf Scholarship to High Point University in North Carolina.
