## David Wilson



As a Raider swimmer, David was a four-year varsity letter winner, school record holder, county champion, conference champion, a state champion, and an automatic "All American". He was an integral part of many Raider swimming championships. His teams won the Skyland Conference Championship Meet in 2009 and were the Group 4 Central Jersey State Sectional Champions in 2006, 2007 & 2008. Individually, David was the 2009 Somerset County Champion in two individual events, the 50 Freestyle and the 100 Butterfly.

David also won both those events at the Skyland Conference Championship meet in 2009 as well. David made team history on the state level his senior season when he won the 50 Freestyle at the Meet of Champions. This marked the first time the Hillsborough Boys Swim Team had a "State Champion". David won the 50 freestyle and set a new school record. David's time in the 50 Freestyle qualified him to earn "Automatic All American", an award that recognizes the top 100 times in the nation for high school swimmers. David was also a member of the 200 Medley Relay that finished in 1st place at the Meet of Champions. This also marked the first time the boy's team had a relay crowned "State Champion". The 200 Medley Relay recorded the second fastest time in state history and earned an "Automatic All American" award as well. David was also a member of the 200 Freestyle Relay & 400 Freestyle relays that both finished in 2nd place at the 2009 Meet of Champions and earned "All American Consideration" time standards.

David's 200 Medley Relay team still holds the team record at Hillsborough HS and David is now the former record holder in the following events: 50 Free (2009-14), 200 Freestyle Relay (2009-14), and the 400 Freestyle Relay (2009-14).

David also received many post-season awards. In 2009 he was selected 1st Team "All State" (50 Freestyle), 1st Team "All State" (200 Medley Relay), 2nd Team "All State" (200 Free Relay), 1st Team "All Area" (50 Freestyle), and 1st Team "All Skyland Conference (50 Freestyle).
