Ebony Young



Ebony is a 2009 graduate of Hillsborough High School. While running at Hillsborough, Ebony was a four-letter winner for both winter and spring track. During her four years, Ebony helped the teams win multiple Somerset County and Skyland Conference Championships.

Individually, Ebony was Somerset County Champion in the 400 meters, Somerset County and NJSIAA sectional Champion in the 400 meter hurdles in 2007. In 2008, Ebony was Somerset County, Skyland Conference, NJSIAA section 4 and NJSIAA group 4 champion in the triple jump. In her senior year she was NJSIAA group 4 indoor sectional champion in the 55 meter hurdles and won the indoor Eastern States Championship in the triple jump.

Ebony earned her first All American medal by placing 6th at the Indoor Nike National Championships in triple jump. Ebony continued her success into her spring season senior year. She was the Skyland Conference and Somerset County Champion in both the 100 meter and 400 meter hurdles. Ebony was Skyland Conference, Somerset County, NJSIAA group 4 sectional and NJSIAA State champion in the triple jump. In Ebonys' final National Championship meet she placed 4th in the triple jump with a distance of 40'3.25" which is still the current school record. Along with being named first team All-Conference, All Area Courier news, All-County Star Ledger and first team All-State, Ebony finished her last spring being named Somerset County Athlete of the Year.

After leaving Hillsborough High School, Ebony went on to compete at Western Texas College and finished her collegiate career at Northern Michigan University.
