# Registration Information for NCAA Eligibility Center

### STEP 1: Go to web3.ncaa.org/ecwr3

To create a new account scroll down to the middle of the screen and then on the left side of the screen under Division 1 or Division 2 click create an account. Then on the next screen scroll to the bottom of the screen and click create an account again. You will then have to enter your email address and then a verification code will be sent to your email address. Then put in the verification code in the box. Now create your account.

Fill out all of the information.

You will need a credit card to pay the \$90 fee

## **STEP 2: Submitting Standardized Test Scores**

Students are responsible for sending their SAT or ACT scores to the NCAA Clearinghouse. You can do this by:

- 1. Put in the NCAA Eligibility Center code 9999 when you register for the SAT's or ACT's.
- 2. Do it online at collegeboard.com or actstudent.org (credit card required)
- 3. Phone 1-866-756-7346(credit card required)

#### STEP 3: Requirements for eligibility

#### **Division 1 Student Athletes**

- 1. All prospective Division 1 student athletes must have a minimum of a 2.3 Grade Point Average (GPA) in 16 core courses (\*academic courses only).
- 2. SAT score requirement is based on a sliding scale according to your GPA. SAT minimum score 980, ACT minimum score 75 (add all sub scores).
- 3. 10 of the 16 core courses must be completed by the end of the junior year.
- 4. 7 of the 10 core courses must come from English, Math and Science
- 5. All prospective student athletes must graduate high school

#### **Division 2 Student Athletes**

- 1. All prospective Division 2 student athletes must have a minimum of a 2.2 Grade Point Average (GPA) in 16 core courses.
- 2. SAT/ACT score requirement is based on a sliding scale according to your GPA. SAT minimum score of 920 or ACT minimum score 70 (add all sub scores).
