You are cordially invited to attend Hillsborough High School's annual Back-to-School Night.

**DATE: Wednesday, September 11, 2019**

**TIME: 7:00 P.M. – 9:15 P.M.**

**PLACE: Hillsborough High School**

This program begins with your child's advisory homeroom, followed by an abbreviated school day, and is designed so you may follow your child's schedule using shortened periods. Lists of the homeroom assignments will be posted inside the entrances to the building for your convenience, and copies of your child's schedule and building maps will be available in homeroom. Schedule information is also available in Genesis if you want to review it beforehand (knowing the homeroom in advance will be particularly helpful!). Throughout the evening, you will meet your child's teachers, who will discuss classroom procedures, course overviews, homework requirements, and methods of testing and grading. Please understand that, due to the time constraints of the evening, individual students will not be discussed. Please stop by the Commons during passing time between classes to enjoy refreshments donated and served by members of the Student Council. You will also have the opportunity to pay membership dues (\$15) to the HHS Home & School Forum in homeroom, if you choose to do so.

**For seniors and their parents**, there will be group meetings with the counselors at 6:00 P.M. for information on planning for the future, the college application process, and other transition pointers. Location information will be distributed in a separate alert from the department. For our parents of younger students in high school, feel free to stop in the guidance offices and meet the counselors during the evening's schedule. Keep in mind that the counselors are housed on separate floors according to the students' house assignments. For students with last names beginning with the letters A through L/M, the counselors' offices are located on the second floor immediately up the stairwell from the Commons. For students whose last names begin with L/M through Z, the counselors' offices are on the first floor adjacent to the Commons.

Please be advised that parking is at a premium; you may want to carpool with a neighbor or friend. There will also be a shuttle bus operating between the Park & Ride lot across from the Post Office on Amwell Road for your convenience starting at 6:30 p.m. Also, please adhere to all posted "No Parking" areas at the high school and in the neighboring communities to keep township residents and their property free from inconvenience by this large, high school event.

We have a very talented and enthusiastic staff at HHS, and the teachers are excited to discuss the experiences your child will have in their classes. Back-to-School Night opens the door of communication between parents and teachers for the remainder of the school year so that we can all work together to make this a successful year for your child.
